Terms and deadlines:

The papers will be written in English, JIS format, as the model (see document: Model Paper Doctoral Symposium Oradea) and will have exactly 4 pages. Power point presentations of the paper will be done in Romanian or English, within 10-15 minutes/paper. Accepted papers will be published, after the review, in a volume with an ISBN / ISSN code, published by the University of Oradea.

The full paper (4 pages), accompanied by a file containing only the title of the paper in Romanian and English and authors' names will be sent by email to sesiunedrdec@gmail.com until 4th of November, 2016.

There will be accepted for publication only the papers submitted strictly within the deadline, that fully comply the requirements of formatting, in Economics and related area (Economic / Social Sciences / Law) and meet the scientific requirements of such events.

All papers will be reviewed by members of the Scientific Committee. The papers which do not fully comply to the formatting rules will be automatically rejected, before the reviewing process.

The notification of acceptance / rejection of paper will be sent by email to the PhD. student until 19th of November, 2016. Publication of the papers in the Conference Proceedings will be done after the session, by the end of 2016.

The Ph.D. students may submit a maximum of two papers, either as sole author or with their PhD. coordinator, or with another PhD student(s). There are not accepted papers with more than 4 co-authors. There will be also admitted papers authored by recent Ph.D. graduates (who obtained the PhD title in the last 5 years) and from post-doctoral students.

Publishing opportunities:

The conference paper (4 pages) will be published free of charges in the conference volume. Additionally, all authors could submit extended versions of their papers, with different title (between 8 and 10 pages, according to the journal's requirements), to be published in "Oradea Journal of Business and Economics - OJBE" – Issue 3 (March 2016) <http://ojbe.steconomiceuoradea.ro/> and the "Annals of the University of Oradea, Economic Sciences Series/Analele Universității din Oradea, seria Științe Economice", Volume II (December 2015) – <http://anale.steconomiceuoradea.ro/en/> – journals indexed in multiple international databases. The extended papers will have to meet the journal's criteria and they will pass through standard reviewing process. The extended papers have to be sent until 1st of December 2016 (for the "Annals"), respectively 1st of February 2017 (for OJBE).

Fees and payment:

There is no fee for participation in the conference and publication in the Conference Proceedings. Eventual travel expenses, accommodation and meals will be borne by the participants.

For publication of the extended version of the paper in Oradea Journal of Business and Economics - OJBE there is no fee. For publication in the Annals of the University of Oradea, Economic Sciences Series/ Analele Universității din Oradea, seria Științe Economice, the fee is 150 lei (approx. 35 EURO).
